



SAGF 2019 MEMBERSHIP FEES

15 November 2018

1. Ordinary Members (Provinces)

- 1.1. The Membership Fee for SAGF Ordinary members (Provinces) is calculated as a percentage of the registration fee of Individual Membership and Institution Membership in the Province.
- 1.2. The Provinces assign the function of collection of all registrations to SAGF through its Registration and Management System.
- 1.3. Registration fees stipulated below outline (1) the maximum fee that a Province can charge as registration fee to its members (individuals and institutions), (2) the fee due to SAGF per category; and (3) a calculation of the portion that is due to the Province and to the Club based on the maximum fee.
- 1.4. Membership Fees are non-refundable.

1.7. Registration Categories Definitions

Institution	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any club, school, university, community centre or institution registered with their District as a category A, B, C or D institution.
Category A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who participates in SAGF competitive structures
Category B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who does not participate in SAGF competitive structures or is only involved in Gym for All discipline. If a member is a supporter or only a judge they register as a category B. <i>This category is purely non-competitive and makes no distinction between whether a member comes from an advantaged or disadvantaged background.</i>
Category C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who participates in SAGF competitive structures, and the institution is a NPO, or the individual's family comes from a financially disadvantaged background. <i>Provinces are requested to put appropriate mechanisms in place to assist in preventing abuse of Category C registration by any of their members in their Province.</i>
Category D	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any institution or individual who takes part in Gymnastics for free (no fees are paid by individuals to coaches for lessons). This also refers to a coach or judge who is an educator that only coaches or judges in a school and at inter-schools league competitions. These are schools involved in the SRSA Schools Sport Programme and community centres that are purely recreational (non-competitive) that do not charge class fees. Only Category D Institutions can register Category D individuals.
Category E	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any individual who participates in Inter Club Competitions only. Only Category A and C Institutions can register Category E individuals.
Life Member	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An individual who wishes to be registered with the Federation for their lifetime. This is a once off payment and does not have to be repeated again. The Life membership is a Category A membership.

APPENDIX A: TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Overview

- 1.1. SAGF consists of three categories of members, as per clause 7 of the SAGF Constitution, namely:
 - Ordinary Members;
 - Special Members; and
 - Associate Members.
- 1.2. SAGF Membership will be awarded annually upon receipt and approval of an application for membership by SAGF and the Province.
- 1.3. The membership cycle is from 01 January to 31 December. Members are required to renew their membership each year however members will be given 90 days grace period in the new year between 01 January to 31 March to renew their membership.
- 1.4. Membership Renewal deadline is the first Monday of April each year.
- 1.5. Renewal applications received after the Membership Renewal Deadline will be subject to penalty fees, which are decided and imposed by the SAGF EXCO.
- 1.6. New Members can apply any time during the year and will not incur penalty fees.
- 1.7. Membership fees are non-refundable.

2. Ordinary Members

- 2.1. It is compulsory that every Province confirms their official registration fees to SAGF by 30 November each year, as this information must be loaded on the Registration and Management system ahead of the registration cycle (01 January - 31 December).
- 2.2. Any levies imposed by the Province to their members, and the purpose thereof, should be clearly explained to their members. Such levies may not be phrased as SAGF Membership Fees.

3. Special Members

- 3.1. According to the SAGF Constitution, a Special Member, means any body of persons representing active and current registered Gymnastics participants competing and/or taking part in any of the disciplines of Gymnastics under the auspices of SAGF, irrespective of their gender or age categories.
- 3.2. The SAGF Athletes Commission is the elected body of the Special Member acting on behalf of Gymnasts.
- 3.3. There is no Membership Fee required for the SAGF Athletes Commission.

4. Associate Members

- 4.1. According to the SAGF Constitution, an Associate Member, means a national association or organisation that has –
 - the same or similar objects to SAGF;
 - its National Office within the area of jurisdiction of SAGF;
 - applied to SAGF to become an Associate Member of SAGF; and
 - been accepted as an Associate Member of SAGF by SAGF in writing in terms of the provisions of the SAGF Constitution;
- 4.2. A Fee for Associate Membership will be determined by the SAGF EXCO.
